Notes

The Education Pipeline theme of the Bowen Health Workforce Information Portal (HWIP) presents health workforce data on various licensed health professionals. These data are obtained through online surveys administered during the biennial license renewal process. These data are currently available for four licensed professions; Physicians, Nurses, Dentists and Dental Hygienists. **It is important to note that these data represent only a sample of their respective workforces and include only those who completed the online re-licensure survey.** Response rates and additional data pertaining to these workforces are available in data reports published at <https://medicine.iu.edu/research/centers-institutes/bowen-health-workforce>. Users may visualize the data based on selected geographies including County, Area Health Education Center Regions, Economic Growth Regions, and Public Health Preparedness Districts. These data were collected during the 2015-2017 biennial licensure renewal period.

Definitions

Medical School, Proportion of Foreign Trained represents the proportion of actively practicing professionals who attended medical school outside of the United States.

Medical School, Proportion Indiana Trained represents the proportion of actively practicing professionals who attended medical school in Indiana.

Medical School, Proportion Out of State Trained represents the proportion of actively practicing professionals who attended medical school in states other than Indiana.

Residency, Proportion of Foreign Trained represents the proportion of actively practicing professionals who attended residency programs outside of the United States.

Residency, Proportion Indiana Trained represents the proportion of actively practicing professionals who attended residency programs in Indiana.

Residency, Proportion Out of State Trained represents the proportion of actively practicing professionals who attended residency programs in states other than Indiana.

Degree, Proportion Indiana Trained represents the proportion of actively practicing non-medical professional who completed the training that qualified them for their license in Indiana.

Proportion who is a National Certified Counselor is the proportion of behavioral health professionals who have a National Certified Counselor (NCC) certification.
