Summary of cross-border philanthropy

Data on cross-border giving in Greece comes from the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD).

SENDING CROSS-BORDER CHARITABLE DONATIONS

Generally, cross-border giving is permitted in Greece. Donations to philanthropic organizations (POs) based in the European Union and the European Economic Area (EU/EEA) receive the same tax benefits as donations made to domestic organizations (Indiana University Lilly Family School of Philanthropy, 2018). Comparable foreign POs in the EU/EEA also benefit from income tax exemptions that apply to domestic-based POs.

RECEIVING CROSS-BORDER CHARITABLE DONATIONS

There are no known restrictions on receiving cross-border charitable donations.

ESTIMATED CROSS-BORDER GIVING

According to data collected by the OECD, cross-border giving in Greece was USD 320,000.
