2024 SUPPLY AND DEMAND

BACKGROUND

Health workforce planning begins with gathering information on practicing health professionals to better understand the services they provide and their capacity. Data can then be used to project workforce supply and demand and proactively identify potential workforce gaps. This snapshot provides a summary of supply and demand estimates and projections for Indiana's dental hygiene workforce.

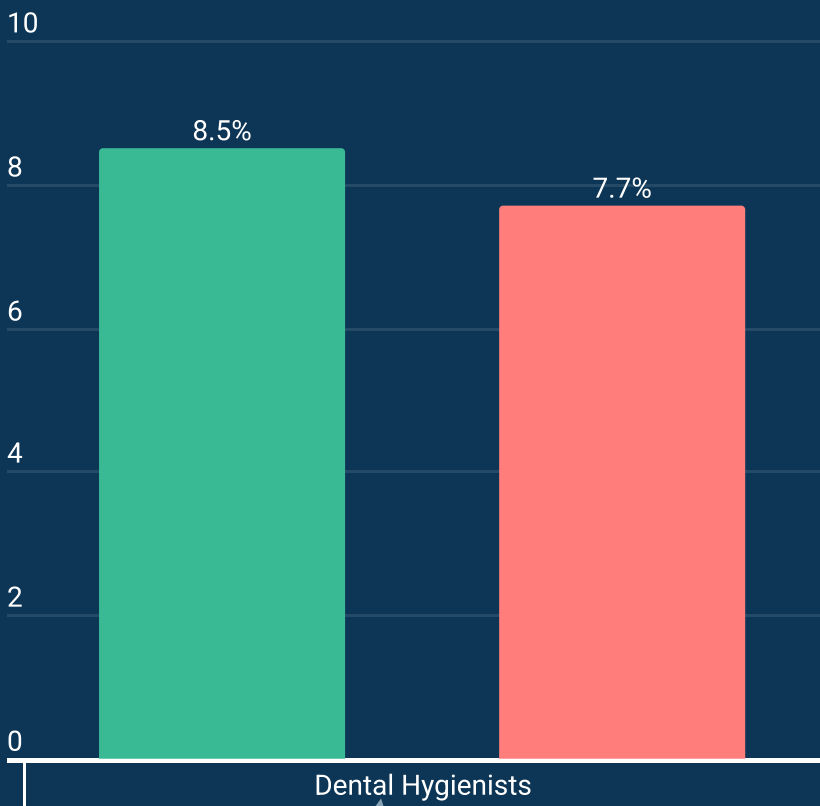
The supply data are sourced from the 2024 Oral Health Workforce Data Report. The demand data presented in this snapshot are sourced from Lightcast using the following terminology and the last quarter of collected data.

- Jobs: Estimated number of employed Dental Hygienists.
- Growth: Estimated change in the total number of workers employed as Dental Hygienists.

ANTICIPATED JOB GROWTH, 2025 - 2035

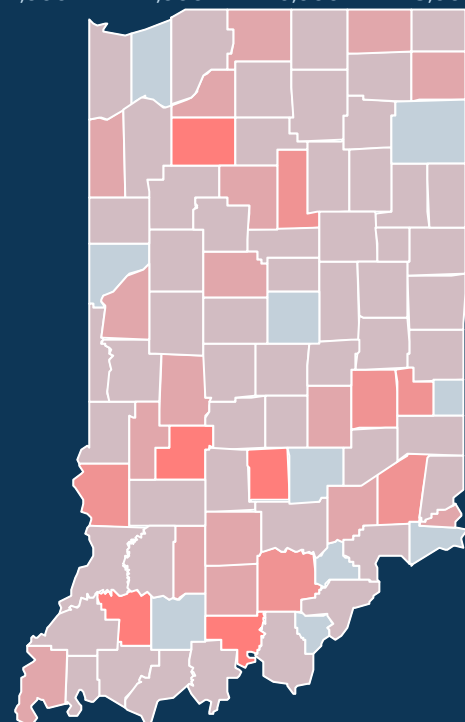
