A Brief on Indiana's Health Workforce


Where does Indiana's licensed health workforce self-report receiving their qualifying education?

Indiana is fortunate to have a mechanism to collect and report on the characteristics of Indiana's health workforce. Information is collected from licensed health professions at the time of biennial license renewal. Until 2019, providing information on professional characteristics was voluntary, but many of our licensees participated because workforce surveys were embedded within the license renewal process. While each profession has profession-specific questions, a number of questions are consistently asked of all professions in order to support interprofession comparison, including: "Where did you complete the education that qualified you for your Indiana [profession] license?" This provides the opportunity to compare responses between health professions. The figures below reveal how licensees responded during the 2017-2018 renewal cycles. (Remember, this is just a sample. After the 2019/2020 renewal cycles, this information will represent the total workforce).
